- Students must take at least 30 and no more than 36 hours of CMS coursework. At least 15 of these hours must be upper-division.
- A student may not enroll in more than nine hours of CMS courses in one semester.
- No more than 60 hours of Communication coursework can count for degree credit.
- To enroll in upper-division Communication courses, students must have an overall GPA of at least 2.25 and a 2.0 GPA in all Communication courses.
- A grade of C or better is required in each course taken in the Moody College and no Communication course may be taken on a pass/fail basis.
