- Students must take at least 36 and no more than 48 hours of CMS coursework. At least 18 of these hours must be upper-division.
- A student may not enroll in more than nine hours of CMS courses in one semester.
- A student may not double major in Communication Studies and Communication and Leadership.
- **No more than 60 hours of Communication coursework can count for degree credit.**
- A grade of C- or better is required in each course taken in the Moody College (some courses require a higher grade to advance in the degree), and no Communication course may be taken on a pass/fail basis unless it is only offered as pass/fail.
- Students must have a 2.0 overall GPA at UT and in Moody College coursework in order to graduate.
- Only 1 hour of Music Performance and 1 hour of PED coursework each may be counted toward a degree in the Moody College.
