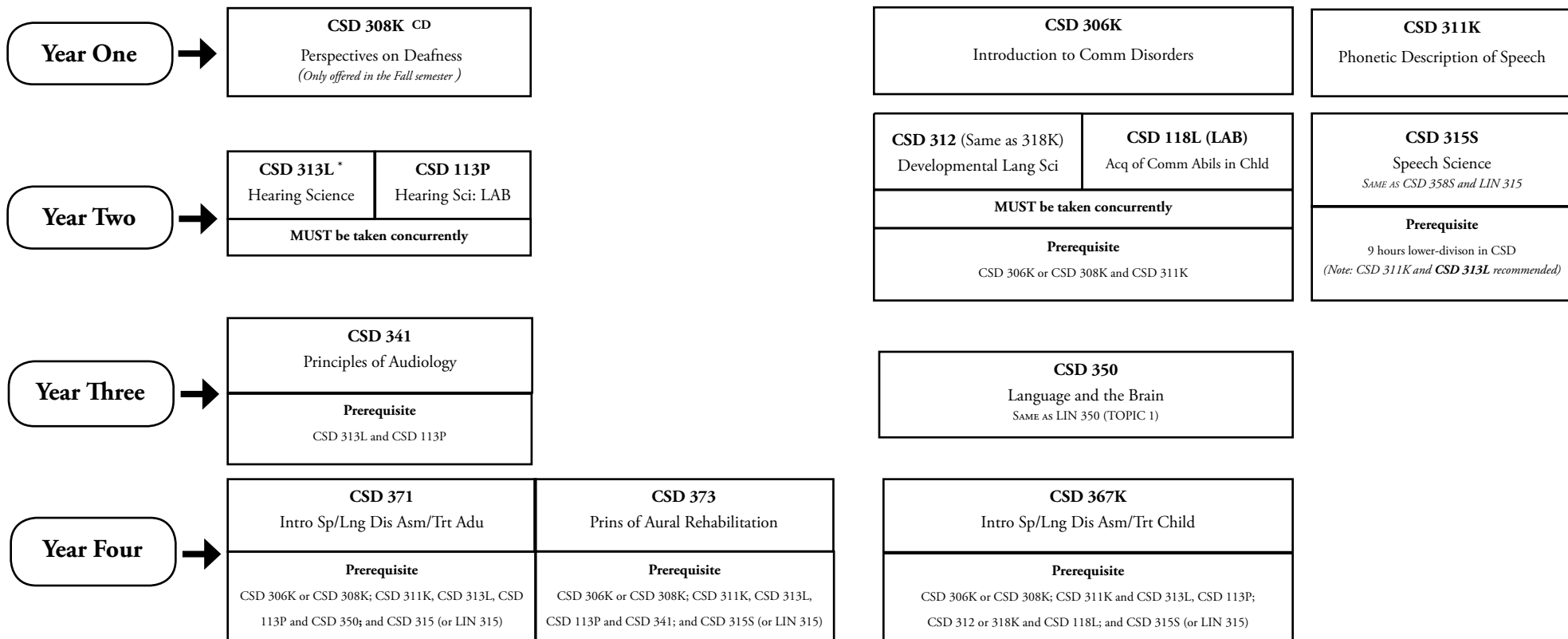

Major Requirements:

- Students specializing in SLP or Audiology must complete at least 35 semester hours of coursework in CSD (15 hours of this coursework must be upper-division).
- No more than 48 hours of CSD coursework may be counted towards the degree.

CSD 140L Prof Issues in CSD. Students wishing to obtain twenty-five (25) hours of observation should enroll in CSD 140L (Only offered in fall and spring semester). May NOT be counted toward any degree.

Prerequisite: Upper-division standing and twelve semester hours of coursework in communication sciences and disorders.

What I should Know about CSD:

- CSD 367K and CSD 371 registration requires students submit an application and reserve a spot in this classes (Only offered in the fall and spring semesters).
- CSD 341 and CSD 373 **may not** be taken concurrently.
- CSD 175N Deaf Education Seminar. Students specializing in SLP or Audiology may count no more than two semester hours in this course toward the degree.
- A grade of C- is worth 1.67 grade points.
- *Class-level flags will be approved for particular unique numbers and particular instructors on a semester-by-semester basis. These flags will appear only in the Course Schedule.

Rules to Live By:

- No course in the Moody College may be taken pass/fail, unless it is offered only on that basis.
- A grade of C- or better is required in every Communication course taken in order to count toward the degree requirements unless otherwise specified by the department.
