- 42 hours of Journalism must be taken. No more than 45 hours of Journalism coursework may be counted toward the degree.
- Students may not enroll in more than 9 hours of Journalism coursework per semester.
- Students must complete at least 72 hours outside Journalism.
- **No more than 60 hours of Communication coursework can count for degree credit.**
- A grade of C- or better is required in each course taken in the Moody College (some courses require a higher grade to advance in the degree), and no Communication course may be taken on a pass/fail basis unless it is only offered as pass/fail.
- Students must have a 2.0 overall GPA at UT and in Moody College coursework in order to graduate.
- Only 1 hour of Music Performance and 1 hour of PED coursework each may be counted toward a degree in the Moody College.
