**MAJOR REQUIREMENTS**

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- A student may not register for most upper-division sequence courses without acceptance into one of the six sequences within the School of Journalism.
- Course prerequisites may include testing, interviews, and/or other coursework. See your advisor for more information.
- To enroll in J 315 and most upper-division journalism courses, students must score at least 45 on the GSP test and 29 on the WP test.
- Students may not enroll in more than 9 hours of Journalism coursework per semester.

**Note: No more than 42 hours of College of Communication courses can count for degree credit.**

**JOURNALISM COURSES:** At least 33 hours of Journalism must be taken. Photojournalism students are required to take 36 hours of Journalism courses. No more than 36 Journalism hours may count toward the degree.

## NATURAL SCIENCE, PART II \_\_\_\_\_

Three (3) hours in a discipline other than that used to fulfill the Part I requirement. Any course listed for Natural Science Part I may be counted.
