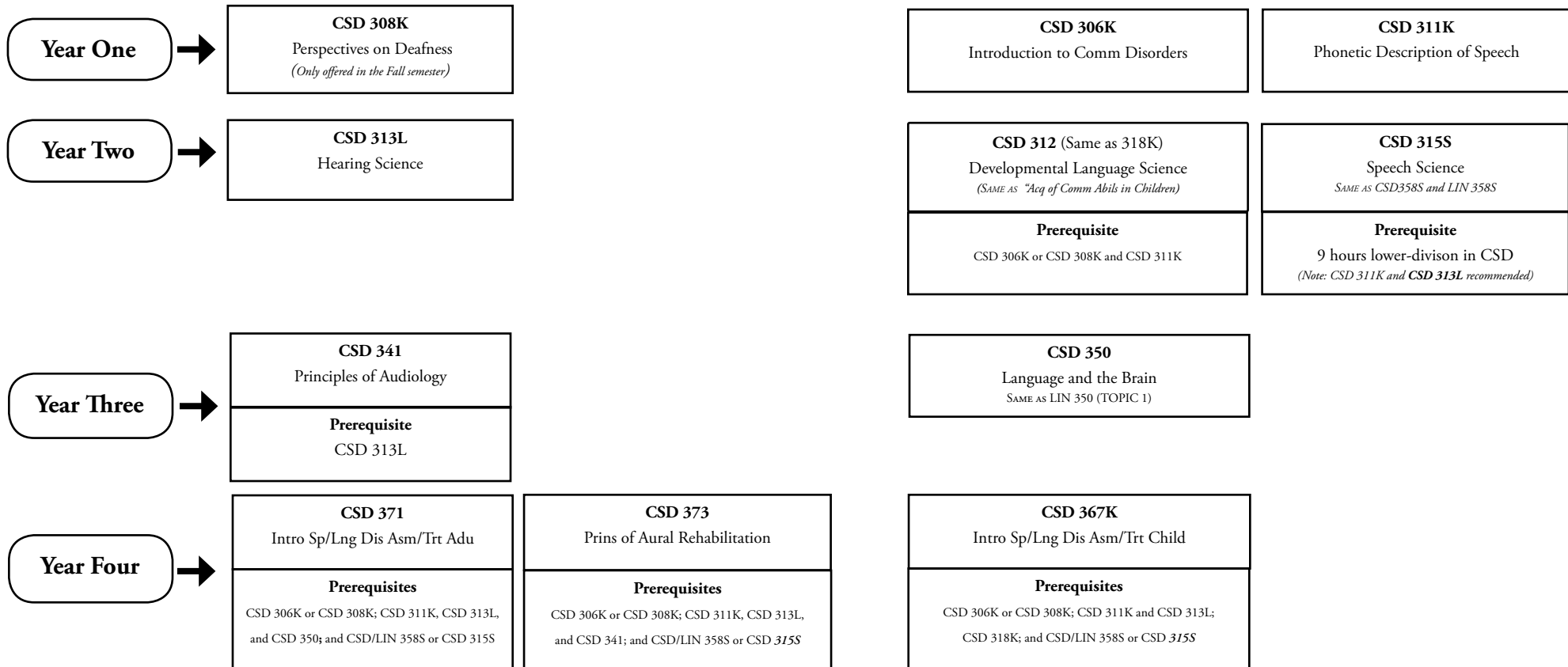


Communication Sciences & Disorders 2016-2018 Audiology & Speech Language Pathology

Major Requirements:

- A maximum of 33 semester hours of CSD coursework is required (15 upper-division and 18 lower-division). No more than 42 hours of CSD coursework may be counted towards the degree.
- To enroll in Upper-division College of Communication Courses, students must have an overall GPA of at least 2.25 and a 2.0 GPA in all College of Communication courses.

CSD 140L Prof Issues in CSD Students wishing to obtain twenty-five (25) hours of observation should enroll in CSD 140L (Only offered in fall and spring semester). May NOT be counted toward any degree.

Prerequisite: Upper-division standing and twelve semester hours of coursework in communication sciences and disorders.

Special Requirements:

- No course in the Moody College may be taken on a pass/fail basis, unless it is offered only on that basis.
- You must earn a grade of C or better in your Communication courses in order for them to count toward the degree requirements.
- A grade of C- will not count in Communication courses. A grade of C- is worth 1.67 grade points and a 2.0 COM GPA is required.
