



## Texas Civic Ambassador (TCA) Program Requirements

- **Remain in good academic standing** with their institution of higher learning and act as a respectful representative of the program throughout their year of service.
- **Attend the Texas Civic Ambassador Leadership Summit** on August 15 – 18, 2019 at The University of Texas at Austin. *Meals, parking, and housing accommodations will be provided. Transportation to Austin is offered through travel stipends.*
- Organize or participate in at least **one nonpartisan (or bipartisan) outreach activity** on your campus or in your local community on an issue pertaining to civic life.
- **Promote New Politics Forum events** on your college campus and to your student network.
- **Identify a mentor on your campus** who will support your year of service, help you plan educational outreach activities, and promote NPF events.
- **Attend at least one New Politics Forum event** during your year of TCA service. Participation in person is preferable, however when available, remote participation will be permitted to fulfill this requirement. *Meals, parking, and housing accommodations for TCAs will be provided for select activities. Transportation to Austin is not always included.*
- **Submit two “journal” entries** (one in December; one in May) that share about your experience.
- **Complete necessary paperwork** to become approved to receive travel accommodations.
- **Sign the TCA code of conduct and program requirement agreement.**
